Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

Medical Bravo Ltd is committed to achieving Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 in line with UK Government targets.

We recognise the importance of reducing our environmental impact and are committed to implementing measures to monitor, manage, and reduce our carbon emissions across all areas of our operations.

As a provider of teleradiology and telemedicine services, we support the NHS Net Zero ambition by delivering digital healthcare solutions that reduce the need for patient and clinician travel, thereby contributing to lower system-wide carbon emissions.

We will continue to develop and implement a structured carbon reduction strategy and will review our progress annually to ensure alignment with national and NHS sustainability objectives.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline Year: 2024

Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations:

Medical Bravo Ltd was established in 2024, and this year represents the first available dataset for carbon emissions reporting and therefore serves as the baseline year.

Baseline emissions have been calculated using available operational data and reasonable estimates where primary data is not yet fully available. Calculations have been undertaken in accordance with the Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol and with reference to the UK Government GHG Conversion Factors for Company Reporting.

Given the nature of our operations as a provider of teleradiology and telemedicine services, direct emissions are limited. The primary sources of emissions arise from purchased electricity, employee commuting, business travel, and operational waste. As a predominantly digital service provider, upstream and downstream transportation and distribution emissions are currently considered negligible.

These figures represent an initial baseline for the Company’s UK operations. Medical Bravo Ltd is committed to improving the accuracy, completeness, and granularity of emissions data over time as carbon accounting processes mature.

Current Emissions Reporting

Medical Bravo Ltd was established in 2024; therefore, the baseline year is the first year of emissions data collection. As a result, the current emissions reported remain aligned with the baseline year, and no material reduction has yet been recorded.

The organisation is in the process of embedding carbon measurement and management practices and will use this baseline to track progress in future reporting periods.

Medical Bravo Ltd is committed to improving the accuracy and completeness of emissions data over time and will implement processes to enable year-on-year emissions tracking, reporting, and reduction.

Emissions Reduction Targets

To continue our progress towards achieving Net Zero, Medical Bravo Ltd has adopted the following carbon reduction targets:

- A reduction in absolute greenhouse gas emissions of **20% by 2028** from the 2024 baseline year
- A reduction in absolute greenhouse gas emissions of **50% by 2035** from the 2024 baseline year
- Achievement of **Net Zero emissions by 2050**

These targets will be reviewed periodically to ensure they remain aligned with UK Government policy, NHS Net Zero ambitions, and emerging best practice.

Medical Bravo Ltd will also seek to improve emissions intensity over time by reducing emissions per unit of service delivered, reflecting increased efficiency in digital healthcare delivery.

Progress against these targets will be measured annually against the baseline year and reported as part of ongoing carbon reporting.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Medical Bravo Ltd is committed to implementing a range of carbon reduction initiatives to support the achievement of its emissions reduction targets and Net Zero commitment.

As a provider of teleradiology and telemedicine services, the Company's operating model inherently supports carbon reduction by minimising the need for patient and clinician travel and reducing reliance on physical healthcare infrastructure.

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2024 baseline:

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

- Adoption of a predominantly remote service delivery model, reducing the need for patient and clinician travel
- Implementation of remote working practices, minimising office-based energy consumption
- Procurement of energy-efficient IT equipment, including laptops and monitors with improved energy performance
- Reduction in business travel using digital communication and collaboration tools



Ongoing and In-Progress Initiatives

- Monitoring and improving the measurement of Scope 1, 2, and 3 emissions to enhance data accuracy
- Encouraging low-carbon commuting options where travel is required
- Reviewing business travel policies to prioritise virtual engagement wherever possible
- Assessing the environmental performance of key suppliers and service providers

Planned Future Initiatives

- Transition towards the use of cloud and data hosting providers powered by renewable energy sources
- Development of a formal carbon management plan to support continuous emissions reduction
- Integration of sustainability considerations into procurement processes, including preference for suppliers with Net Zero commitments
- Further optimisation of digital systems and workflows to reduce energy consumption and improve efficiency
- Ongoing reduction of waste and promotion of responsible disposal and recycling of IT equipment

These initiatives will contribute to measurable emissions reductions over time and support the Company's commitment to sustainable healthcare delivery.

The Company will continue to identify and implement additional opportunities to reduce emissions and will review progress on an annual basis.
